

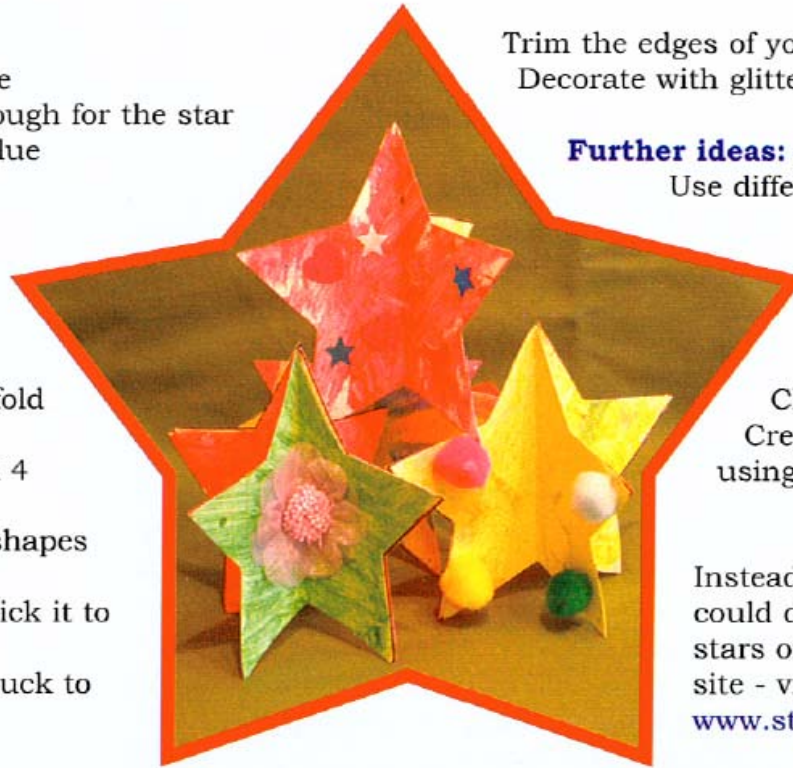
# Make a 3D Star Decoration

## You will need:

Half a five-pointed star template  
4 squares of thin card – big enough for the star  
glitter, coloured/shiny paper, glue

## Instructions:

Cut out the half star shape to use as your template.  
Fold the cardboard squares exactly in half.  
Place the template against the fold of the card.  
Draw round the template on all 4 pieces of card.  
Carefully cut out the half star shapes through the 2 layers of card.  
Glue one half of the star and stick it to one half of another star.  
Repeat this until each half is stuck to another half.



Trim the edges of your 3D star if necessary.  
Decorate with glitter, shiny paper, felt tips etc.

## Further ideas:

Use different coloured squares of card.  
Make a Christmas mobile using several different sized star templates.  
Attach a loop to the top of each star and hang on your Christmas tree.  
Create a 3D Christmas Tree by using a half Christmas Tree template.
