- Now tie it to our thank you tree.

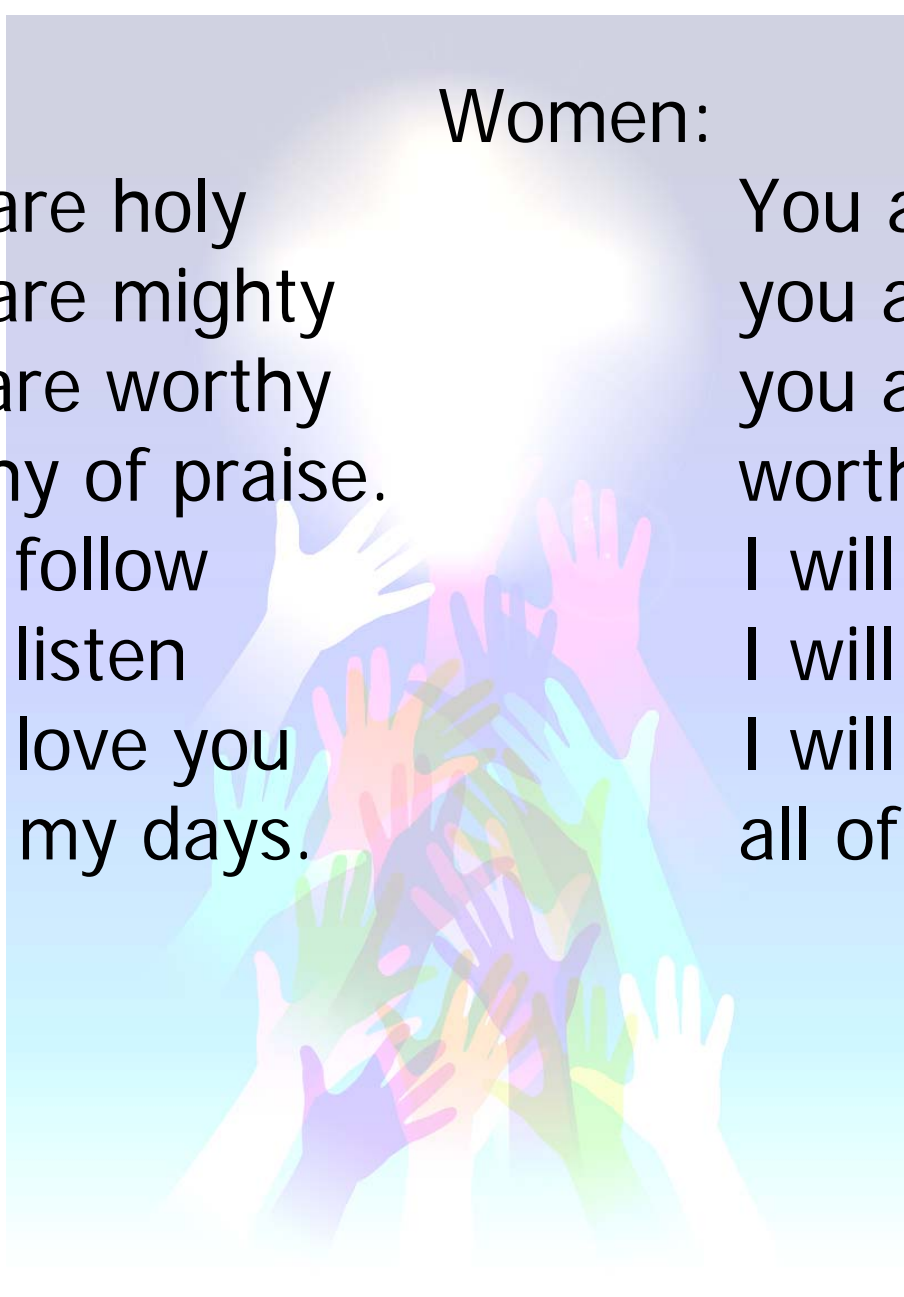
